YEAR IN REVIEW 2018-19





We have had a very successful year and Ding Yi is proud of its many achievements.

Our ensemble played a record number of concerts in a variety of locations, and to different audiences. We were particularly active on the outreach and education fronts reaching out to more communities. Highlights included *Getai Date with Mum*, a celebration of Mother's Day with *Getai* veterans Liu Ling Ling, Angie Lau and Wang Lei; *Masterpieces by Gu Guanren*; the third *Modern Voices: Music from the Turn of the Century; Composium 2018; Southern Charms: An Evening of Cantonese Classics*; and *Of Music and Photography: Bridge*, our annual multidisciplinary series.

In December, Ding Yi was invited to do sound sampling for the renowned music company Scoring Berlin, in Bangkok. The sound sampling of our Chinese instruments will be used to develop a music software. In March, we held *Rhapsody of Romance*, a concert cum fundraising gala dinner with veteran pianist Mdm Elaine Wu, flautist Rit Xu and Peking Opera actress Huang Ping. Our Patron, Mrs Goh Chok Tong, graced the occasion by performing four arias with our ensemble. We remain immensely grateful for our supporters and donors as we managed to raise over \$\$550,000.

In closing, I would like to thank Mrs Goh Chok Tong, our board of directors, conductors and musicians, as well as our management, staff and volunteers for their efforts. A special word of gratitude to Mr Joseph Chia, our chairman since 2014, who retired in October 2019, but agreed to continue as a valued member of our board of directors.

LOCAL CONCERTS



ESPLANADE CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC SERIES – ONWARDS: A RUAN & ZHENG RECITAL 17 Apr 2018

VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio

Showcasing the versatility and elegance of the traditional Chinese plucked string instruments, *ruan* and *zheng*, this recital presented homegrown talents Yvonne Tay and Jonathan Rao's aspirations in musicianship. Besides the newly arranged *Impression of Guangling*, which was derived from the classic *guqin* piece, *Guangling Melody*, the concert also featured notable signature works, including renowned composer Prof Dong Li Qiang's *Shu Ying* and Robert Zollitsch's *Boat Against the Current*. The duo also premiered a new commissioned work by Ding Yi's composer-in-residence, Phang Kok Jun, as the finale.

GETAI DATE WITH MUM 6 May 2018

VENUE: Esplanade Concert Hall

Celebrating Mother's Day with famous *Getai* veterans Liu Ling Ling, Angie Lau and Wang Lei together, Ding Yi brought the vibrant *Getai* culture into the concert hall. This concert featured a medley of classic Teochew, Cantonese and Hokkien music in a chamber music setting for the special women in our life - our mothers. This concert is in collaboration with Shan You in partnership with Nirvana Memorial Garden.

MASTERPIECES BY GU GUANREN 9 Jun 2018

VENUE: SCO Concert Hall

Following 2016's sold-out concert, *Tunes from a Teahouse*, renowned composer Gu Guanren and conductor Quek Ling Kiong led Ding Yi to showcase his best works in the concert. Gu is widely acclaimed for his culturally significant music. His works have been performed in many countries, including Singapore, China, Hong Kong and Taiwan. The concert presented Gu's Chinese chamber works and featured a special performance starring Ding Yi musicians with invited youth musicians to perform Gu's classics. The highlight of the concert *Capriccio in Blue*, is a local premiere composition and his most recent represented work.

FEED YOUR IMAGINATION - BUKIT HO SWEE: A MUSICAL JOURNEY THROUGH CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC 4-7 Jul 2018

VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio

Students joined the musicians of Ding Yi as they presented a live music performance accompanied by theatre, singing, and multimedia. Composed by Phang Kok Jun and directed by Danny Yeo, this immersive experience allowed students to not only better understand Chinese chamber music, but also learn about local history, personal bravery, and the importance of community spirit. This production is co-produced by Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay and Ding Yi.







MODERN VOICE III - MUSIC FROM THE TURN OF THE CENTURY 20 Jul 2018

VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio

For the very first time, Cultural Medallion recipient and Singapore Chinese Orchestra Music Director Tsung Yeh conducted Ding Yi in an evening of Chinese chamber music. Together, they presented a repertoire of traditional Chinese chamber music created in 1990 to 2004 which showcased contemporary Chinese composition techniques while being rooted to their musical origins. Ranging from traditional folk music to elegant court music and spiritual paeans, these works included Jia Daqun's *Three Movements of Autumn*, as well as concert highlight, Chen Yi's *Song of Five* performed by the renowned China's "First Chinese Cellist" Chu Yi-Bing.

ESPLANADE CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC SERIES – SOUTHERN CHARMS: AN EVENING OF CANTONESE CLASSICS 8 Nov 2018

VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio

Led by Ding Yi's concertmaster Chin Yen Choong and *huqin* musician Fred Chan, Ding Yi presented a night of traditional Cantonese music. Together with *pipa* musician Chua Yew Kok, *dizi* musician Ng Hsien Han and *yangqin* musician Yick Jue Ru, the quintet performed their renditions of classic Cantonese tunes including *The Bird's Return to the Forest, Autumn Moon Over the Calm Lake* and *The Sorrow of Lady Wang Zhaojun. Gaohu* virtuoso and Cantonese music expert, Yu Lefu, took on the role as the concert's artistic advisor and performed his work *Snowflakes in Dream* with Ding Yi.



COMPOSIUM 2018 3 - 5 Aug 2018

VENUE: NAFA Lee Foundation Theatre and Esplanade Recital Studio

Ding Yi organised the Third International Composition Competition for Chinese Chamber Music, Composium held from 3 to 5 Aug 2018. Composium 2018 is a triennial festival spearheaded by Ding Yi since 2012, to encourage local and international, aspiring and experienced composers to compose for Chinese chamber music, as well as advocating the genre to the public. In Composium 2018, we have received 58 submissions, of which 16 are from Singapore. A total of two concerts, one workshop and one symposium were presented during the Composium.

OF MUSIC AND PHOTOGRAPHY: BRIDGE 2 Dec 2018

VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio

A multidisciplinary Chinese chamber music concert conducted by Quek Ling Kiong. We often think of bridge as a tool. It serves as a meeting point between people, a link-way connecting two ends, and a medium that fills the gap. In different cultures, a bridge is more than just a connection; it can be a means of refuge, a highway to a new beginning, or a landmark that we remember. Ding Yi breaks the music boundary by presenting on immersive ouperionee and talling stories of the

an immersive experience and telling stories of the bridges in Singapore through music, photography and multimedia.

HAPPY CHINESE NEW YEAR CONCERT 2019 17 Feb 2019

VENUE: China Cultural Centre

The fourth of the series in collaboration with China Cultural Centre, Ding Yi celebrated the joyous festivity with a myriad of refreshing jovial Chinese tunes and pop music. Two home-grown young talents, Mediacorp artistes Jarrell Huang and Bonnie Loo were featured in the concert. Ding Yi *pipa* musician Chua Yew Kok, *guzheng* musician Yvonne Tay and our new *suona* musician Jacky Ng were the featured musicians performing renditions of popular Chinese classics.

FUNDRAISING GALA CONCERT - RHAPSODY OF ROMANCE 13 Mar 2019

VENUE: Tanah Merah Country Club, Tampines Course Banquet Room

The third run of fundraising gala event for Ding Yi featured veteran pianist Mdm Elaine Wu, flautist Rit Xu, Peking Opera actress Huang Ping to a packed hall of 300 guests. The Chairperson of the Fundraising Committee and Patron of Ding Yi, Mrs Goh Chok Tong graced the occasion with four soprano works with the ensemble. With the support of guest-of-honour Minister Ms Grace Fu, the event managed to raise a total amount of more than \$550,000.

SOUND SAMPLING FOR SCORING BERLIN I – IO Dec 2018

VENUE: Bangkok, Thailand

Ding Yi was invited by renowned music company Scoring Berlin who is one of the best sound sampling companies in the world. The sound sampling of our instruments took place in Thailand and were used for the making of a Chinese instrumental music library in the music software Orchestral Tools.

EDUCATION & OUTREACH PERFORMANCES

NATIONAL ARTS COUNCIL – ARTS EDUCATION PROGRAMME Apr 2018 to Mar 2019

VENUE: Various Primary and Secondary Schools

This project is aligned with National Arts Council's aims to provide quality, purpose driven programmes to cater to the wide range of student needs. Ding Yi was invited by various education institutions to share about Chinese chamber music genres through specially crafted content such as *Percussive Storm, Jiangnan Silk* and *Bamboo* as well as *Xinyao*. A total of six performances had been held in this financial year.

DING YI OUTREACH "GO LOCAL!" SERIES – BLOSSOMING MELODIES & RECOLLECTING MELODIES 22 Apr & 19 Aug 2018

VENUE: Shaw Foundation Symphony Stage, Singapore Botanic Gardens

To tie in with the Singapore Orchid Show at the Singapore Botanic Gardens, Ding Yi performed an array of Asian floral-themed repertoire including *Give Me A Rose, Bunga Sayang*, and various pop songs for the audience to sing along with. In the second concert of the series, Ding Yi presented familiar theme songs of the favourite local television and movie productions such as *Little Nonya, Tofu Street, I Not Stupid* and more. Both concerts showcased the unique flavours and culture of Singapore.



AN EVENING OF MUSIC 30 Apr 2018

VENUE: Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre Auditorium

A private event held by the humanitarian activities of HH Gyalwang Drukpa. Ding Yi was invited to perform repertoire which reflected the harmonious interaction between traditions and modernity.

DING YI & SOTA: PASSING NOTES 27 July 2018

VENUE: SOTA Concert Hall

Passing Notes is Ding Yi's first collaboration with the School of the Arts' Music Faculty. Led by Ding Yi's Assistant Conductor Wong De Li, Dedric, the concert featured joint performances by Ding Yi and SOTA in pieces such as Songs of the Herdsman, dizi solo by SOTA student Neo Rui Zhi, and Dance of the Mountain, pipa solo by SOTA music student Parveen Kaur. The SOTA Chinese Percussion Ensemble also presented General's Expedition and Rhythmic Drums.



NATIONAL ARTS COUNCIL SILVER ARTS – GOLDEN MELODIES & RELIVING REDIFFUSION WITH DING YI 8 & 14 Sep 2018

VENUE: Kampung Admiralty Community Plaza & Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre Auditorium

In *Golden Melodies*, Ding Yi presented the golden tunes from the past decades and familiar theme songs of favourite local television such as *Little Nonya* and *Tofu Street* at the new Kampung Admiralty Community Plaza. In collaboration with former radio presenter Eva Chang, Ding Yi relived "Rediffusion", a multilingual broadcast programme which championed the Singapore entertainment scene in the 1950s by re-enacting the radio station's former glory on stage. Ding Yi performed familiar evergreens by 1980s famous singers like Teresa Teng, Fei Yu-Ching and Fong Fei Fei. GARDENS BY THE BAY'S MID-AUTUMN FESTIVAL 21 Sep 2018

VENUE: Supertree Grove, Gardens by the Bay

Ding Yi collaborated with Young People's Performing Arts Ensemble and local singer Olinda Cho to present a night of cultural appreciation to celebrate Mid-Autumn Festival. The performance included a series of lovely classics such as recitation of the Chinese classic text San Zi Jing (or Three Character Classic) and familiar tunes *Love Song of Kangding* and *Moonlight in the City*.





TIME FOR OPERA! – MONKEY KING 20 Jan 2019

VENUE: Festive Arts Theatre, Our Tampines Hub

In collaboration with Chinese opera company Traditional Arts Centre and Indian dance company Bhaskar's Arts Academy, the show presented the classic tales of the Monkey King in the Chinese fable Journey to the West and Indian fable Hanuman. Starring local talent singer and actor Sugie Phua, the production featured a unique and fun interpretation of the Monkey King with an ethnic twist, specially catered for families.

NATIONAL ARTS COUNCIL ARTS IN YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD -MUSIC ON THE MOVE 17 & 23 Mar 2019

VENUE: Tampines, Carpark at Blk 872A Street 86 and Tampines Community Plaza

With a musical truck and a pop-up stage, Ding Yi presented a series of vibrant music performances around the Tampines neighbourhood. These music performances featured new compositions by young and old residents of Tampines, inspired by a trip around the neighbourhood led by a historian and Ding Yi's composer-in-residence.




