### Year In Review 2019-20

### Who could have imagined, as we sailed through 2019 with a series of successful concerts and achievements, new challenges await us at the end of the year.

We look back at the many key developments of the company, including the appointment of Ms Elvia Goh as our general manager, before COVID-19 became the determining factor in our lives. Covid-19 could be around for the next few years and it could mean that we can't go back to the way we lived, worked, performed and enjoyed music as soon as we wished. Therefore, we must get accustomed and embrace the new normal. Since February 2020, our ensemble quickly adjusted to the new normal and launched a series of online programmes.

As we look ahead, we must view COVID-19 as an opportunity, rather than a threat. It is also an opportune time for us to go back to our roots - a Chinese chamber ensemble. We are fortunate in that Ding Yi is relatively small and can perform in smaller venues. It enables us to do intimate concerts, and even perform in residences to provide an immersive music experience. We will therefore use the coming year to encourage our musicians to further develop their artistic, as well as their social skills and confidence, by performing in unusual, innovative ways and in different environments.

I would like to thank our Patron, Mrs Goh Chok Tong, our board of directors, conductors and musicians, as well as our management, staff and volunteers for helping us get through these challenging times and for working on our future as Singapore's leading Chinese chamber music ensemble together.

### Year In Review 2019-20

We started the season with a rousing concert *Sounds of Percussive Wind* and continued with other successful concerts, including the majestic performance in *Masterpieces by Peng Xiuwen*; the fun and educational *The Musical Canvas*; and *Musical Frontiers*, which brought together Ding Yi and the famous Vietnamese ensemble Suc Son Moi, known for their unique bamboo music. This was followed by the fourth edition of our biennial Ding Yi Chinese Chamber Music Festival, with captivating performances of the Sound of Dragon (Canada), 3peoplemusic (Taiwan) and the Tang Family Music Ensemble (China.) When we performed the year's closing finale *Of Music and Story: River of Life*, on 15 Dec 2019, it did not cross our minds that it would be our last live concert for quite some time.

Our *Happy Chinese New Year Concert*, scheduled for 8 Feb 2020, unfortunately had to be cancelled at the last minute. However, only a week later, Ding Yi played its first digital concert *Together We Stand* featuring local celebrities such as Joanna Dong, Tay Kexin, Liu Ling Ling, Wang Lei, together with Minister Grace Fu. It was meant to instil positivity and provide encouragement to society-at-large, amidst the worries and uncertainty caused by the pandemic. Shortly afterwards, Ding Yi released a digital initiative – #dingyiwithyou, a series of digital content available across all Ding Yi online platforms.

The new year brings new directions, new hopes, new opportunities as we focus on what is possible and to innovate. We are nimble as a small company with our principal conductor Mr Quek Ling Kiong, assistant conductor Mr Wong De Li, Dedric, musicians and staff. They are stars by themselves and as a team. We also have significant support from the government, sponsors, donors and many others. This is extremely important to us as we keep up in the new normal. We look forward to offering you new possibilities as we all adjust to the new normal.

遗憾的是,原定于2020年2月8日举行的农历新年音乐会因疫情的关系,最后一刻不得不取消。然而,仅仅一周内,鼎艺团呈献首个现场线上音乐会《鼎力相助 艺起加油》,参与表演的嘉宾有本地著名歌手董姿彦、郑可心、刘玲玲、王雷等,以及文化、社区及青年部部长傅海燕女士。在新冠疫情所引起的忧虑和不确定中,我们旨在灌输正面的能量,并为社会各界提供支持与鼓励。此后不久,鼎艺团在社交媒体上呈献#鼎艺陪伴你(#dingyiwithyou)系列,推出线上音乐会及短片视频,为宣扬希望与正能量的当儿,供大众宅在家中时仍然能欣赏华乐。

即便疫情,崭新的一年也代表了新的指标、新的希望、新的机遇让我们能在艺术领域创新。鼎艺团虽然规模小,但是志愿大,在首席指挥家郭勇德,助理指挥黄德励,以及演奏家和工作人员们群星合力,一起克服难关。此外,我们也得到了来自政府,赞助商,捐助者等等的大力支持。这对我们非常重要,帮助乐团在新常态下继续保持运作。我们期待为您提供更多新的可能性,并且一起适应新的常态。

# ESPLANADE CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC SERIES: SOUNDS OF PERCUSSIVE WIND 4 Apr 2019

### **VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio**

Demonstrating the dynamic characteristics of Chinese bamboo instruments *dizi*, *sheng* and the versatility of Chinese percussion, this is an energetic chamber performance led by Ng Hsien Han, Soh Swee Kiat and Low Yik Hang. Featured favourite Chinese classic such as *The Phoenix Soaring into the Sky, Return of the Swallow* and *Night Thoughts*.

### MASTERPIECES BY PENG XIUWEN 21 Apr 2019

### **VENUE: Singapore Conference Hall**

Peng Xiuwen is one of the prominent and notable figures in the development of the Chinese music scene. The concert featured some of his masterpieces, showcasing the artistic prowess of renowned Chinese music husband and wife duo, *yangqin* virtuoso Zhang Gaoxiang, and *huqin* doyenne Jiang Kemei and also reputable *huqin* musician Xu Wenjing. This concert was sponsored by Qiu Zhai Art Foundation.

# FEED YOUR IMAGINATION 2019 - THE MUSICAL CANVAS 16-18 Jul 2019

### **VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio**

The Musical Canvas follows the story of a painter who uses sounds to find inspiration for her art. These concerts were well received by primary school students and had many sold out shows. This is in collaboration with the Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay.

### DING YI CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVAL 2019 13 - 15 Sep 2019

### **VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio**

A biennial festival featuring performances by renowned overseas Chinese chamber music ensembles, accompanied with a series of talks. In this year's fourth edition of the festival, Sound of Dragon Ensemble from Canada, 3peoplemusic from Taiwan and Tang Family Music Ensemble from China were featured. Some of the renowned musicians include *pipa* master Tang Liangxing (China) and conductor Chen Chih Sheng (Taiwan).

### ESPLANADE CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC SERIES: SOUTHERN ELEGANCE – MUSIC OF THE TEOCHEWS 5 Nov 2019

### **VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio**

A classically elegant evening of traditional Teochew music, featuring renowned Teochew music master and National First Grade composer Wang Peiyu as concert artistic advisor. The sold-out concert presented renditions of classic Teochew repertoire such as *The Lion's Mischief, Lotus Blossoms, Waves Sifting Sand* and a special performance with Wang in *Spring Brocades*.

### MUSICAL FRONTIERS 11 Aug 2019

### **VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio**

Musical Frontiers brings together different cultures and genres to present a unique cross-cultural collaboration. The third edition of Musical Frontiers featured the award-winning Vietnamese Bamboo Ensemble, Suc Son Moi with Ding Yi. Led by young conductor Dong Quang Vinh, Suc Song Moi is the only bamboo ensemble in Vietnam known for their unique bamboo music performance and compositions.

### DY-LOGUE 27 Oct 2019

### **VENUE: Stamford Arts Centre Blackbox**

A new experimental series to showcase musical dialogue between two musicians of very different music backgrounds, yet using very similar ethnic instruments. Set in an intimate musical salon setting, the first in the series featured our *pipa* musician Chua Yew Kok and Malay gambus musician Azrin Abdullah.

### OF MUSIC AND STORY: RIVER OF LIFE 15 Dec 2019

### **VENUE: Esplanade Recital Studio**

Inspired by the late senior reporter and historian Han Tan Juan's famous literature about the stories of our Singapore River. This multidisciplinary concert, through music, storytelling and multimedia, sheds light upon the great historic river which once was the very heart and lifeblood of our island's economy. The two concerts attracted full house and were well received by the audience, of which many of them has sparked memories and reflections amongst themselves.

Spreading love and joy to the community using music, Ding Yi conducted three "Music For You" performances at various hospitals and hospice. They are Ng Teng Fong General Hospital on 30 Aug, Tan Tock Seng Hospital on 17 Oct, and Dover Hospice on 5 Dec.

### #DINGYIWITHYOU Feb to July 2020

While adapting to the everchanging COVID-19 landscape, Ding Yi launched a series of content under the digital banner #dingyiwithyou, with the aim to instil positivity and encourage fellow Singaporeans and our international friends as we ride out the storm of the global COVID-19 outbreak. The series include Ding Yi Encore! featuring free full-length recordings of Ding Yi most iconic works and concerts from the past, #togetherwestand featuring bite-sized video content with uplifting messages, and Onstage vs Offstage which is a social media takeover by our Ding Yi family. Till date, we have produced more than 10 videos, which reached out to more than 60,000 views in total.




FY19/20


### Donations (S\$)


Ding Yi received 41% less in donations for FY19/20.
