MESSAGE FROM GENERAL MANAGER

2021-22

Ding Yi Music Company moved from mainly digital in 2020 to more hybrid style productions in financial year 2021. Although the end of the COVID pandemic is nowhere near in sight, we have been increasingly able to put on many successful live performances. We anticipate this trend to continue in the months and years to come.

We can look back with pride on our debut in the Singapore International Festival of Arts 2021, when our ensemble, led by principal guest conductor Quek Ling Kiong, presented "Healing Rhapsody", a musical journey of reflection, realisation and inspiration. National Arts Council's Silver Arts 2021 "I Only Care About You" concert brought back many unforgettable melodies of Teresa Teng, via a first of its kind in Singapore spectacular holographic performance, and virtual choir Voices of Singapore.

Our first hybrid *Composium* 2021, the fifth edition of Ding Yi's triennial composition festival, included workshops, symposiums, open rehearsals and two concerts, held at the Esplanade Recital Studio. Composers, from many countries including China, the USA and Mexico, submitted more works than ever before with a record-high number of submissions received.

Our musicians, conductors Quek Ling Kiong and Wong De Li, Dedric, and our five-people strong management team have performed well once again, resulting in a busy year of performances for Ding Yi. We must continue to look for ways to further increase the quality of all aspects of our work.

At the beginning of 2022, we started work on our 15th anniversary programmes. We also signed new memoranda of understanding with our long-term partners Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre and the China Cultural Centre. The two collaborations serve to formalise the partnership with both institutions and Ding Yi's commitment to uplift and promote traditional Chinese arts and culture through Chinese chamber music.



As always, Ding Yi has made a special effort creating our community and outreach programmes. We performed live at several schools, the Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre and Gardens by the Bay, as well as online to bring Chinese chamber music to as many people as possible in Singapore.

All of this would not have been possible without the active support of our Patron, Mrs Goh Chok Tong; our advisor, Minister Grace Fu; our chairman Patrick Goh and our board of directors; as well as all others who continued to support Ding Yi Music Company during this extraordinary year.

鼎艺团在2021财政年度在演出形式上做了些调整。2020年乐团的主要演出形式是线上音乐会但在 2021 财政年转型为混合型演出。虽然冠病疫情的结束至今仍遥遥无期,但鼎艺团在过去的一年内成功举办的现场演出有增无减。我相信这一趋势将在未来的几个月,甚至几年,都持续不断。

鼎艺团在2021年的新加坡国际艺术节第一次亮相。这场音乐会《回疫录》在首席客座指挥郭勇德的带领下,陪伴观众一起走上这趟充满反思、感悟、启发的音乐之旅。鼎艺团也在国家艺术理事会主办的乐龄艺术活动《艺悦乐龄2021》的《我只在乎你》音乐会,让观众回味多首邓丽君经典名曲。音乐会也利用全息投影技术让 "邓丽君"在舞台上绽放光彩和鼎艺团与线上合唱团 "新声合唱团" 一起同台演出,令观众叹为观止。

《作弹会》是鼎艺团主办的作曲比赛,这项三年一度的活动于 2021 年迈入第五届,也是第一次尝试现场与线上模式。《作弹会2021》活动多元,包括工作坊、座谈会、公开彩排,以及两场在滨海艺术中心音乐室举办的音乐会。来自包括中国、美国、墨西哥等地区的作曲家反应热烈,参加比赛作品数量创历史新高。

鼎艺团的11位全职音乐家、指挥郭勇德和黄德励以及管理团队的五位成员在 2021 年维持出色的表现,让乐团在过去一年呈现多场演出。同时,乐团在财务管理方面采取审慎的态度。乐团还是必须不断精益求精,让我们在各个面相都持续成长,追求更高水平的表现。

2022年初,鼎艺团展开一系列的15周年庆活动。鼎艺团也和长期合作伙伴新加坡华族文化中心以及中国文化中心签署了新的合作备忘录。这两份备忘录旨在通过华乐室内乐发扬及推广华族传统艺术和文化。

7 April 2021 Stamford Arts Centre, Black Box

DY-Logue is an experimental series providing Ding Yi musicians an avenue to freely express their artistry and musicianship.

This edition showcases two young percussion virtuosos sharing a collaborative spirit to the beat of their own drums, finding their inner voices and beyond, and pushing their artistic limits through their exchange of distinct Chinese and Malay percussion techniques and styles. Low Yik Hang and Riduan Zalani attempt synchronicity and divergence in syncopation, presenting an interesting conversation across cultural and musical divides.

SONGS OF THE DRAGON KILN

30 May - 6 June 2021 Online (SISTIC Live)

Songs of the Dragon Kiln is a multidisciplinary experience that premiered in 2017 to critical acclaim in collaboration with Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre. Ding Yi launched its Disappearing... series with this production featuring a seamless blend of documentary film and pottery with Chinese chamber music. Ding Yi reprised this unique concert, shining a spotlight on one of Singapore's fast-fading heritage – the Dragon Kiln. The showcase was part-archival and part-commentary on vanishing trades, paying homage to a beloved tradition of Chinese culture.






SINGAPORE INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF ARTS 2021 -HEALING RHAPSODY

COMPOSIUM 202I

17 - 19 December 2021



Composium 2021 is the first ever hybrid edition where festival programmes were made available both physical and online to encourage participation from local and overseas attendees in-lieu of the restrictions. This is also the first time Ding Yi Music Company onboarded new partners including programme partners, Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts and Composers Society of Singapore, and online media partners in China, Hua Xia Xuan Yin and Yue Tong Tian Xia.

The triennial composition competition event consists of three segments including a series of symposium by renowned international composers, 2 open rehearsals and concerts featuring works by the 9 finalist composers and an esteemed panel of international adjudicators.

This edition received the highest number of submissions (88 compositions) since the inception of Composium in 2012. Submissions came from various countries and regions, including Malaysia, China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, United States of America, Madagascar, Mexico, Croatia and Singapore. This echoed Ding Yi's continuous efforts in advocating Chinese chamber music through working with local and international composers in creating new and outstanding works.

This year's composition competition revolves around two themes - Chinese Festivals and Customs (Category A) and Life Sentiments (Category B1 and B2). Category A encourages composers to develop their own interpretations on festivities such as Chinese New Year, Mid-Autumn Festival, Winter Solstice, and more, while Category B1 and B2 represents our composers' thoughts and reflections on modern life in a pandemic world. The competition culminated with prize winners for the Audience Choice Award, Young Singaporean Composer Award and Hua Xia Xuan Yin Audience Choice Award (new to Composium 2021).

WHAT IT TAKES IN INTERPRETING **CONTEMPORARY CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC?**

Musicians are the bridges between the composer and audience to make a composition come alive. In this symposium, the panel discussed how musicians can work together with the composer to enhance and perform these contemporary works while maintaining their individuality.

COMPOSITION COMPETITION: THEMATIC VS FREE WRITING

In this symposium, Ding Yi invited Composium 2021's finalist composers to debate and discuss on the differences between thematic versus free style composition writing.



COMPOSITIONAL DEVICES OF CHINESE VS WESTERN MUSIC

Many composers who write for Chinese instruments initially come from Western music backgrounds but that does not mean that they are unable to appreciate and subsequently learn to write for a Chinese chamber ensemble. This symposium explored this topic with examples of effective writing for Chinese chamber music.

WHAT'S NEXT FOR CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC

When Composium was inaugurated, Chinese chamber music was still a relatively new genre. Aspiring groups like Ding Yi first worked with reduced orchestra pieces, before realising its limitations and started to commission new works. Today, they have a body of commissioned repertoire but many issues still prevail. This symposium tapped on the panel's expertise to explore various ways to help Chinese chamber music develop and progress further.

PRIZE PRESENTATION CONCERT




Donations 赞助

Sources of Income 收入来源




Total Income 总收入

The total income recorded for FY21/22 increased by 16% from the previous year to \$1.55 million despite a 24% decrease in donations. The increment is primarily attributable to an uptick in performance revenue with the re-introduction of live performances following the easing of COVID-related safe distancing measures.
