Who We Are

To us, composing, interpreting and performing Chinese chamber music transports us to realms—from the historic to the contemporary and avant-garde, from places exotic and familiar, from the sensual to the surreal.

At Ding Yi, it is not only about the sounds we make, but also the journeys we take. Each piece is carefully crafted to transport us, and you along with us, from the cloistered chambers of an imperial age to the expansive imaginations of our modern collective soul, to touch, entertain, understand, unite and inspire.

And it is this passion and formula that have won us the accolades and support of patrons, arts institutions, and chamber music fans across Asia. The journey starts with us, but continues with you. Won't you join us as we continue to explore and create a unique sound for Singapore?

Known as the "People's Conductor", Quek Ling Kiong is the Principal Conductor of Ding Yi Music Company, establishing the ensemble as a trailblazer in pushing the boundaries of Chinese chamber music. His core Chinese music training at the Shanghai Music Conservatory, China, and later his Western music training at the Zurich University for Arts, Switzerland, inspires him to create many profound intercultural music productions that resonate across communities. His charismatic conducting style and innovative music programming have made him an influential leader in promoting Chinese music. Of note are the two Ding Yi Music Company's iconic programs the triennial Ding Yi Chinese Chamber Music festival and Ding Yi 's international competition and symposium for Chinese chamber music works - Composium. He is also

famous for his children's educational shows internationally. Quek is a recipient of the Singapore National Arts Council's Young Artist Award (2002); the Cultural Fellowship (2013), COMPASS Singapore's Meritorious Award (2016), and featured as one of iconic personality by Singapore Lianhe Zaobao in 2018. In 2019, Singapore Management University (SMU) established "Quek Ling Kiong Arts and Cultural Scholarship" to inspire and support undergrads to venture into management especially for traditional arts. As a guest conductor, Quek has worked with many international orchestras. In China, he worked with Shanghai Chinese Orchestra, Guangdong Chinese Orchestra, Jilin Chinese Orchestra and more. He has also conducted the Hong Kong Chinese Orchestra and Macau Chinese Orchestra, and performed with the Taiwan Kaohsiung Chinese Orchestra. Quek is currently the Resident Conductor of Singapore Chinese Orchestra and Music Director of Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra. In his free time, he conducts SMU's Chinese Orchestra and lead as their Music Director. His strong beliefs in breaking down barriers for the special needs community with music lead him to be the Artistic Director and Conductor of Singapore and Hong Kong's largest inclusive orchestras - The Purple Symphony and True Colours Symphony.



Wong De Li, Dedric is Assistant Conductor of Ding Yi Music Company, leading Ding Yi's exploration in infusing new forms and genres in Chinese chamber music. Wong holds a Master's degree in Orchestral Conducting from the China Conservatory of Music (Beijing), under the tutelage of renowned Professor Yang Youqing, and guidance from Tsung Yeh, Music Director of Singapore Chinese Orchestra.

Wong is a recipient of the National Arts Council Arts Scholarship, and a two-time recipient of the Singapore Hokkien Huay Kuan Arts and Cultural Bursary. In 2013, he was selected to participate in the Conducting Masterclass, led by conducting maestros Professor Zhang Guoyong and Qu Chunquan, organised by the Taipei Chinese Orchestra. He staged his conducting recital with the China Conservatory of Music Middle School Youth Chinese

Orchestra with conductor Gu Guanren in 2016, and currently holds the title of Conductor at the Asian Cultural Symphony Orchestra. In 2019, Wong was appointed as one of the panel members for the five-year SG Youth Action Plan. In 2020, he was appointed as the Principal Guest Conductor of the Chengdu *Tianziguoyue*.

Wong's role in Ding Yi has fulfilled his teenage aspirations of being a conductor, which he was inspired by Singapore Cultural Medallion recipient Dr Tay Teow Kiat. and he aspires to bringing Ding Yi to new heights of artistic excellence with a uniquely Singaporean direction.
