

# MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN 2022-23

This is my first Ding Yi Music Company Annual Report message since I succeeded Mr Patrick Goh as chairman of Singapore's most exciting and professional Chinese chamber music ensemble. Much has been achieved under Mr Goh's leadership and he has guided us particularly well through the very difficult time of the Covid-19 pandemic.

As we consider our future, we have decided to organise a retreat in May to reflect on where we are today, what it will take to secure an exciting long-term future for our beloved music ensemble and identify priorities to address for the coming years.

We strive to remain a sustainable artistic Chinese music platform and this requires new thinking about the way our ensemble is financed, organised, and managed. We are part of Singapore's arts and music eco-system. We know we are complementary to each other and that the best way forward is to collaborate whenever and wherever this is possible.

On behalf of our entire team, I would like to thank our long-term patron Mrs. Goh Chok Tong; our advisor, Minister Grace Fu; the National Arts Council; our sponsors, donors and volunteers for their unwavering support and constant efforts to make and keep Ding Yi Singapore's leading Chinese chamber music ensemble. I would also like to thank our audiences, who attend our concerts and support us in many ways. Together, we can make Ding Yi ever more successful.

# CHINESE CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVAL 2022

15 to 17 December 2022



Held in collaboration with Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay, Ding Yi Chinese Chamber Music Festival was back for its 5th edition from 15 to 17 December 2022. Through a series of concerts, workshop and a summit livestreamed for the first time to reach out to an international audience, the Festival showcased the best of Chinese chamber music in different presentations and styles to the audience.

A first-of-its-kind score publication which includes a compilation of original Chinese chamber music by local and international composers commissioned by Ding Yi over the last fifteen years.






### Government Grants 政府赞助
